

## **RATE INCREASE 2023**

Public Water Supply District No. 2 of Jackson County distributes water to the southern portion of Raytown Missouri. We purchase all of the water we distribute from Independence and Kansas City, Missouri.

We regret to inform you that the cost of this distribution of water has gone up. As a result of the rising costs, Your Board of Directors will effect an increase in all water rates to our customers to cover these increases of 5%. This is only the second increase in the last five years.

Almost all of our customers will still have lower water rates than their neighboring communities.

Public Water Supply District No. 2 of Jackson County, Missouri is committed to providing ample quantities of high quality water that is both safe and delectable to drink. We strive to maintain continuous service and pressure throughout the system, quickly restoring service following maintenance and repairs. The District has replaced over two thirds of the distribution mains in the last twenty years, keeping our District modern and efficient.

We will diligently maintain the system to last for generations to come, along with excellent customer service to our Raytown residence.

### **Rate Schedule: Monthly**

First 2,000 gallons (Min)	@ \$ 20.70
Above 2,000 gallons	@ 8.65 per 1,000 gallons
